

- 2. Selection will be done entirely on the basis on marks obtained in Tier- II Exam.
- 3. There is a negative marking of 0.50 Marks for each wrong answer.
- 4. There is no provision of sectional cut off .
- Only those candidates who are shortlisted by securing a minimum qualifying marks in Tier-1 are eligible to appear in Paper II & Paper III
- There will be a negative marking of 1 mark for each wrong answer in Paper-I and and 0.50 marks for each wrong answer in Paper-II and Paper-III
- Paper-I will be conducted in two sessions -Session -I & Session-II, on same day.
- Session-I will include conducting of Section-I, Section-II and Session-II will include conducting of Section-III.
- It will be mandatory for the candidates to qualify all the sections of Paper-I.
- DEST will be mandatory for all the posts; however it will be qualifying in nature.

DEST: Candidates are required to type 2000 character or Key depressions in 15 minutes on a computer in English. This test is conducted to check a candidate's typing skills.


